Organic compliance documents

CFIA recently confirmed the type of compliance documents which can be issued by the Certification Bodies. ECOCERT CANADA has thus modified its documents to comply with the Regulation.

	Types of document	Activities	Validity
A	Organic Product Certificate	For agricultural production (including maple syrup) and food preparation	No expiry unless cancelled
B	Labelling and Packaging Certificate	For operators who repack, label organic products	12 months
C	Product compliance attestation (<u>Note 1</u>)	Trading (includes Brokerage and Distribution)	12 months
D	Service compliance attestation	Operators who offer service to organic operators	12 months

Note 1 :

Distribution, trading and brokerage are activities which are not covered under the Canadian Organic regulation and CBs are not allowed to issue « organic product certificates » for these activities. Traders not wishing to obtain an attestation of Compliance can still trade in organic products, provided the organic integrity has been maintained and the full documentation chain for these products is on hand and provided as required.

CBs may issue an **Attestation of compliance** confirming that the operator conducts activities in compliance to the Canadian organic standards and that organic integrity is maintained.

1. The operator can sell the product under this document and does not need to disclose the supplier's information to the buyers.
2. CBs can issue the « Inspection Certificate » (TC) required to export in different countries.

Such a document is issued after an inspection has demonstrated compliance of the trading activities.

Examples :

- Organic farmer who buys from other farmers some products he wish to repack and sell will receive documents A and B
- Processor who also have a line of products he only relabels will receive documents A and B
- Repacker who distribute other products as well, will receive documents B and C
- Farmer cleaning grains for other farmers will receive documents A and D
